RYA Level 1 Powerboat Course

This is a one day introduction to boating including launching techniques, everyday boat handling skills and the use of essential marine safety equipment. The course is suitable for complete beginners with no previous boating experience.

RYA Level 2 Powerboat Course (Displacement)

This is a comprehensive two day course providing the skills and background knowledge needed to drive a powerboat safely in tidal waters. It forms the basis of the International Certificate of Competence. Training will take place in displacement craft and will cover tuition on collision avoidance, boat handling and navigation theory. This course is suitable for club members with some knowledge of boating and previous experience in driving small powerboats.

RYA Level 2 Powerboat Endorsement (Planing)

This is a one day endorsement course for club members who have already completed the two day RYA Level 2 displacement powerboat course. The focus of this course will be the driving of planing craft in coastal waters with an emphasis on improving close quarters boat handling, planing manoeuvres and man overboard recovery skills.

International Certificate of Competence (ICC)

This qualification is required for cruising in many areas outside the UK. It can be included as part of the practical elements of the RYA Level 2 course or for experienced skippers without formal qualifications a direct assessment can be undertaken to provide evidence of your competence to qualify for the ICC. This qualification can be organised on an individual basis at anytime. Please contact the sailing club if you require further details.

CEVNI Test

A short multiple choice exam, this qualification is a requirement for navigation on most inland European waters. Preparation for the test is essential so contact the training dept for details. This exam can be organised on an individual basis at anytime, please contact the sailing club for further details.

RYA Safety Boat Course

This is a two day course providing the skills required when acting as an escort craft skipper or coach boat driver for a fleet of dinghies. Course content includes training in a wide range of rescue techniques and is suitable for members wishing to gain confidence in providing safety cover for sailing activities at the club. Candidates applying for the course will need at least two full seasons of driving powerboats and must have already completed RYA Level 2 powerboat training.

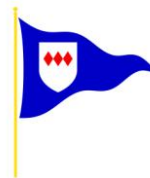
These can also be provided on demand for club members who have already completed any of the above courses and wish to practice skills learnt to increase their confidence using the club boats.

RYA Marine Radio Course (SRC)

This is a one day course for anyone who owns a fixed or hand held VHF radio. The Short Range Certificate is the minimum qualification required by law to control the operation of VHF and VHF Digital Selective Calling equipment on any British flagged vessels. Further courses can be organised on demand, however a minimum of 6 course members will be required to make training viable.

Basic Navigation and Theory course

This course provides an introduction to navigation and safety awareness for new, inexperienced or rusty sailors. Use of charts, tidal and weather information to plan short passages in local waters will form the basis for this course. No previous experience is necessary.

Day Skipper Theory Course

This course is suitable for any cruising sailor wishing to further their knowledge of navigation, safety, weather and passage planning. It will cover international rules for preventing collisions at sea, navigation marks, chart work, weather, tides, safety, passage planning and use of electronic navigation aids. A minimum of 6 course members will be required to make training viable.

All bookings are accepted on condition that the customer agrees to abide by our booking conditions and confirms this acceptance by signing the application and medical declaration form.

The Sailing Club reserves the right to cancel a course should the numbers fail to reach a viable minimum. A transfer to an acceptable alternative date or a full refund will be made. The Sailing Club reserves the right to



cancel or curtail a course due to forecast or prevailing weather conditions, or due to other factors beyond our control. We will endeavour to provide mutually acceptable alternative date(s), but if unable to do so, we will make a pro-rata refund.

All cancellations/transfer requests by course members must be made to the sailing club office. Once notified we will make every effort to resell the course place/s. If the place is resold by us prior to the start of the course, we will refund the course fee. No refund will be made, however, if we are unable to find a suitable replacement for your booking.
